#### OFFICIALS TRAINING 'OFFICIALLY' LAUNCHED



Speedway Australia are proud to launch our comprehensive National Training Program for Official's accreditation. For the past year we have been developing an online platform for Officials training in conjunction with Divisional bodies such as Speedway Sedans Australia and the Sprintcar Control Council, to set a national standard of knowledge and skill sets required for Stewards and Scrutineers across every class of racing.

This new, interactive online programme covers all aspects of Speedway Officiating, from the fundamentals of being an official, to health and safety, Speedway racing rules and on-track scenarios. The program allows for self-paced learning on your PC, mobile or tablet from the comfort of your own home – avoiding the need for time consuming and costly travel from remote areas, saving time and money for Divisional bodies, and the volunteers themselves.


One of the key components in the operation of vintage demonstrations are the host tracks, and the

aim of this survey is to gauge the opinions of venue operators about how vintage demonstrations are conducted. We are also seeking feedback on how the vintage movement can continue to grow and prosper into the future.

#### A SPECIFIC NOTE ON OFFICIALS LICENCES



All track and divisional officials are now able to access the new \$25 Officials licence that we announced last month. One of the eligibility criteria is that the applicant must outline their role when they complete the online form, and the relevant club or track must verify that the person does in fact undertake that role.

We've had the odd person declare their role as "Official", which doesn't give us enough information to process the licence. Please ensure that your personnel are detailing their role when they apply for the licence, so that we can speedily approve and issue licences.




