SUCCESSFUL GRANT APPLICATIONS



From time to time you will see us make mention of a variety of State and Federal grant opportunities available to tracks around Australia. For many tracks, completing the forms required for these grants can prove time prohibitive – however, in each of these cases, our Sport Development Officers are available to assist with this process.

A recent Federal Government grant opportunity saw a number of tracks call on us for assistance, with many receiving funding for infrastructure projects as a result. One such example is Mareeba Motor Racing Club in far

North Queensland, who received in excess of \$10,000 of government assistance to build new grandstand structures at the venue.

Should you be made aware of any grant opportunities which might assist projects at your track, we are more than happy to assist venues with putting together an application. VIC GOVERNMENT FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES



The Andrews Labor Government will help communities provide more opportunities for people to participate in sport and active recreation through a new \$22 million *Local Sports Infrastructure Fund*.

Eligible projects include aquatic centre upgrades, sports grounds and pavilion developments, new sport surfaces, lighting installations, strategic and regional planning, and active recreation facilities such as play spaces and recreation trails.

The fund is part of an \$850 million Government investment in community sport and active recreation infrastructure since 2014, providing better health, wellbeing, social and economic outcomes for Victorian communities.
