Welcome to the 82nd edition of Speedway Australia's Speed eNews.

WA GOVERNMENT FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES



West Australian venues should have received an email from us regarding potential State Government funding for Speedway events across the state in 2020/21.

The Tourism WA's Regional Events Scheme (RES) is an annual funding round for smaller and emerging events in regional Western Australia. The scheme is designed to assist with the development of events as tourist attractions within regional Western Australia, providing a great opportunity for regional West Australian tracks to create major events of their own.

Tracks hosting major events may apply for funding from \$5,000, to a maximum of \$40,000 per year. Of the \$1m of funding available to WA events, \$150,000 has been set aside for the Regional Aboriginal Events Scheme (RAES). To be eligible to apply for the separate RAES funding, your event must deliver Aboriginal activities and experiences through the leadership and participation of Aboriginal people.

All events must be held between July 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021, with applications closing at 5pm on Wednesday 11 December, 2019.

STEWARD AND SCRUTINEER CHECKS





A timely reminder to all divisions as the new season gets underway, that Stewards and Scrutineers require more than just the Racing Officials Licence to Steward or Scrutineer at an event.

Aside from Speedway Sedans Australia who administer their own separate Steward and Scrutineers cards, Speedway Australia will administer a Racing Officials Card for all Stewards and Scrutineers at no cost, to accompany their

Officials Licence. A requirement to hold one of these cards is that all Stewards and/or Scrutineers are to be approved by their relevant club/division.

Further information regarding obtaining a Steward/Scrutineers card, or obtaining the a higher level of accreditation can be found in Section 5.1 – Recognition of Racing Officials in the current Speedway Australia Racing Rules and Regulations, which you may download by clicking here.





ELECTRONIC LICENSING IS COMING...



The biggest change that clubs will notice when the new licensing system is unveiled is that they will be required to log on and approve a licence holder before the licence is issued. Once approved by a club the licence will be processed and activated online, and in the interim a card will also be printed and dispatched. No approval = no licence able to be issued.

We are extremely close to rolling these changes out, so this is a final plea for club administrators to make sure their details are up to date in the licensing portal. You can do this by clicking on the link below, which will still be the main access point once the system changes are made.
