Nominations are now open for the 2022 Australian Speedway Awards and Hall of Fame Ceremony, to be held at the Melbourne Showgrounds on July 2.

We encourage you all to make sure the personalities of past and present who you believe deserve the recognition are nominated. Award categories are:

- Track of the Year
- Most Improved Track of the Year
- Official/Volunteer of the Year
- Photographer of the Year
- Promotional item of the Year
- Innovation of the Year
- Competitor of the Year – Sedan, Open Wheel, Modified, Karting, Youth (5 awards)
- Sportsperson of the Year

Also on the night will be inductions into the Australian Speedway Hall of Fame. ARM RESTRAINTS & WINDOW NETS ARE COMPULSORY



Window nets or arm restraints are compulsory across the board. It's irrelevant what a similar division may do elsewhere, in Australia they must be used at all Speedway Australia tracks. **Triangular helmet/head nets are NOT window nets and cannot be used in their place.** Similarly there are no dispensations for overseas competitors, the rules apply to everyone! **SKAA Karts are the only exception.**

The rule reads as follows:- **15.3 or 16.9: Arm Restraints: Arm restraints must be worn in all classes where a window net is not fitted. Must comply with SFI 3.3 or FIA. (Enforced from 1 July 2018)**

REMINDER

SPEEDWAY AUSTRALIA PERMIT PORTAL:

A reminder to track operators that it is a requirement that you enter the Speedway Portal to confirm whether the permitted meeting was completed or not, if the meeting was not conducted you must provide the reason why.

Don't forget to "Save" and submit.
