TRACK INSURANCE UPDATE 2018-19

We are pleased to advise that there will be no permit fee increases for tracks in the 2018/19 season.

Last year we secured a three-year arrangement with QBE Insurance that delivered substantial savings, subject to an annual review. Thanks to the ongoing efforts of the entire Speedway Australia family there have not been any increases in public liability claims and the agreement will roll into Year two unchanged.

Marsh Advantage will be preparing the annual renewal paperwork shortly, for distribution to tracks. Now is the time to be confirming race dates and anticipating the meeting category types that you will be running, so we can ensure the commitment form approval process moves smoothly for every venue.

TRACK & DIVISIONAL MEDICAL SURVEYS

We are currently reviewing our existing medical and derby standards, and as part of this process are requesting information from tracks and divisions to try and ensure we make informed decisions going forward.

We have yesterday launched two surveys, one for tracks and one for divisions. The track questions revolve around establishing how much each track pays and what level of coverage they receive. We also ask them a few questions about whether they run demolition derbies and if so, how they are conducted. While the divisional part of the survey is a chance for classes to provide us with feedback about the quality of cover at Speedway Australia tracks, and how they perceive that cover to be funded. Through both these surveys we will have a better understanding of medical coverage from all perspectives.

It's important to note that all responses are for the purposes of gathering information only with a view to improving the value that the sport receives for the investment it makes. We aren't aiming to determine non-compliance or issue penalties, but to assist venues and divisions in finding the right balance between cost and service.

In terms of Demolition Derbies, we moved the rules from the Track Operators Manual into the Rulebook 12 months ago, so are after feedback as to how these operate at venues, plus how we can ensure our specs are fit for purpose.

Currently 14 tracks and 11 divisions have already completed their surveys and we encourage all others to please do so.
