# **PUBLIC LIABILITY RENEWALS**



By now, all tracks should have received your renewal invitations from Marsh Advantage Insurance.

We have been asked to remind everyone that the Commitment Form is not the only document in the invitation email. It contains links to more documents, including the Renewal Invitation Letter and Procedure Guide.

Renewal can only be effected on return of the Commitment Form <u>and</u> payment of the Deposit Premium to Marsh Advantage. Please remember the policy does insure for 24/7 non-racing cover as well. Marsh Advantage strongly recommends that you ensure continuity of cover from 31 August.

The Renewal Letter sets out important information including how to pay. Please always email a bank transaction receipt to Mark at Marsh Advantage.

### DEADLINE APPROACHING - TRACK GRANT SCHEME



We are two weeks from the close off of two important Speedway Australia initiatives, the Track Safety Grant Scheme and the Rising Star Officials Program.

Speedway Australia is setting aside \$50,000 for immediate improvements at affiliated tracks, with a particular focus on the following items that can lead to a reduction in public liability claims such as Safety netting, Safety fences, Pit Gates and Venue Maintenance/Design.

We've kept applying for this grant as simple as possible and there is no complicated form to return. Simply forward the relevant quotes for materials (we don't cover labour) and a brief cover note about what you're aiming to achieve.
