### MANAGING YOUR MEDICALS



That time of the year will soon be upon us where Drivers will be looking to renew their Competition Licence. It serves as a timely reminder that some may require an in-date, and legitimate Medical Examination to accompany the Health Statement.

Speedway Australia offers licence applicants the choice of submitting a Speedway Australia medical examination, or a CAMS medical examination, together with the Health Statement.

For drivers UNDER 40 years of age, a medical examination is required:

- Every 2 years if submitting a Speedway Australia Medical, or
- Every 5 years if submitting a CAMS Medical

Regardless of whether you use the Speedway Australia Medical Examination, or the CAMS Medical Examination, each MUST be conducted in accordance with a licenced General Practitioner. Not doing so may result in a penalty as per the 2019 Speedway Australia Rules and Regulations: -

Rule 2.2.2 (b) If a person submits a fraudulent medical form, they will be unable to obtain a licence for 6 months.
