

# COVID-19 UPDATE: PRACTICES UNDERWAY, RACING FROM NEXT MONTH



We are pleased to advise that with the easing of restrictions in some areas, the ability is now there for venues in some areas to open their gates for smaller practice sessions.

Western Australia's gathering rules change from 10 to 20 over the weekend, and even places like Victoria are beginning to allow social recreation for groups of 10 (see link below). In the Northern Territory, Katherine Speedway will commence their season on June 20 and Nhulunbuy on June 27.

If you would like any assistance with enquiring as to whether your venue can be utilised, even for a private testing session then please get in touch with Speedway Australia and we will help you work through your options. We have set up a dedicated COVID-19 team to assist venues through the restart process, being Liz Weaver and Ross Kirby. Their contact details are on the back page.

# ONE DAY PIT LICENCES – FEEDBACK WANTED



We mentioned a few weeks ago we were developing an online pit entry licence, that will negate the need for tracks to prepay \$10 per licence for the triplicate books that we currently issue.

The purchase of the licence will include the completion of the Indemnity Waiver that entrants to the pit area are required to sign. This is a further COVID-19 initiative that will reduce the number of potential contact points at venue entry, and we are looking to see if we can do more of these electronic tasks to keep everyone safe.

Many venues place a surcharge on the \$10 pit licence, and we are more than happy to integrate these into the licence fee if tracks would like us to. It's a bit like the one-day competition licences that include a surcharge for Speedway Sedans Australia, SKAA Karts and AMCA Nationals. Let us know what you think would work best for your track.
