## IF YA AIN'T FIRST, YA LAST!




In motorsport, everyone wants to be first. Except when it comes to applying for or renewing a license.

Unfortunately, applicants often underestimate how many licenses are being processed in any given week and often get frustrated when their application isn't processed on the day before or of an event, leaving them unable to compete.

In our busy period (September-December) our hard working licensing staff can have over 600 licenses to be processed in a week, leaving no guarantees that an application will be done in the time-frame expected. Our system clearly states that an application can take anywhere from 5-to 10 days to finalise, and this is still subject to club approvals and medical approvals.

Annual leave of staff or club secretaries can also be another major delay factor, so we recommend applying for your license well before the renewal date to avoid disappointment.

### **YOUR LICENSE IS ON YOUR PHONE!**



A reminder that your Speedway Australia license is available on your phone via the Speedway Australia phone App available from the Apple Store or the Google Play Store.

Having your license on your phone will save you time at pit entry, and save you \$25 by avoiding postage of a the hard card option!

To link your license:

- 1) Find your licence ID number via your licence confirmation email.
- 2) Via the 'Licence Card' page, enter your ID number and click 'forgotten password'. A temporary password will be supplied via email.
- 3) Enter the temporary password, login and you will be given the opportunity to reset your password.
- 4) Click 'staylogged in' for ease of access in the future.
