
FANTASY SPEEDWAY EXPANDS

2019 is here, and to celebrate we're launching a new initiative for fans from across the sport to enjoy. Fresh from the success of Fantasy World Series Sprintcars, the fantasy speedway concept is being rolled out to support a number of Australian titles in the upcoming months.

These events will be covered by separate one-off fantasy games, allowing fans to test their knowledge of the relevant divisions by selecting five competitors for every event.

The Fantasy Speedway website itself will launch closer to the first weekend of Fantasy events, the AMCA Nationals and V8 Dirt Modified double header at Toowoomba on January 18 and 19.

The most respected racers in the field cost up to \$10,000 each, ranging all the way down to the unheralded newcomers costing as little as \$2,000. Your team consists of 5 drivers, so use your appearance money wisely! Will you pick a few expensive stars and a couple of lesser lights, or will you pick a team of solid mid-tier racers? It's your call. Points are accrued as per World Series season points, and you can change your team up to 4pm each race night based on nominations as of 4pm the day prior.
