This weekly communication serves to keep clubs and organisations up to date on current events, handy tips to improve competition and safety, as well as any changes that may be taking place within the sport.



DIGITAL LICENSING – CLUB PORTAL

A major change coming from our new Digital Licence, is the way which clubs approve licence holders prior to them obtaining a valid digital card. Previously, clubs would take delivery of a licence and distribute them once a membership is valid. Clubs are now required to grant approval via the Speedway Australia club portal – found by following the link below.



Once you log in, you'll come to the main welcome page. On the screen on the left-hand side you'll see 'pending request' list. Click on the blue words 'Show tasks'. This is the most important area of your club portal; each pending task must be actioned with 'approved' before we can process their licence here at the Speedway Australia office.

A new dialog box will open on your screen. In here you will find a list of all people who have applied for a Speedway Australia licence that have listed your club as their home club.

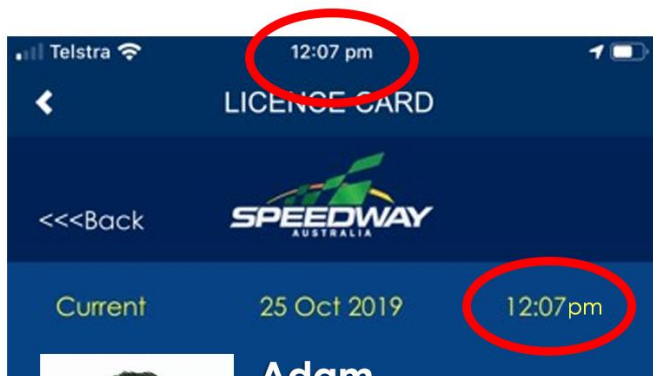
Click 'VIEW' on the first person on the right-hand side

If the person has paid their club membership, the drop-down box will allow you to Approve. (Click 'Approved' and then a box will appear directly under this. Enter the club membership expiry in this box (usually 30/06/2020) and then hit SAVE on the right-hand side.)

You'll need to go through each person listed in that task list and only approve anyone who has completed their club memberships.

We encourage clubs to regularly check their portal and approve any people that have paid their membership, this will allow us here at the office to approve their licences promptly. For anyone that hasn't yet paid, don't decline them just leave them sit there for now.

SCREENSHOT DIGITAL LICENCE – NOT ACCEPTABLE



A key feature of the Speedway Australia digital licence is the ability to view a licence status – be that active, expired or suspended, in real time at the racetrack. A digital licence will appear with the current date and time, even taking into account location and time zone, displayed alongside the licence status above the licence holder's portrait photo.

The main reasoning behind such a feature is to prevent licence holders from being able to present a screenshot of their digital card.

A screenshot licence will of course not display the current date and time – meaning a licence holder attempting to circumvent a suspension, or licence expiration can easily be identified.

When presenting the digital card to a scrutineer or official at an event, licence holders must display their licence through the Speedway Australia app. A screenshot of a digital card will not be accepted as a valid licence.

UPDATED CONTACT DETAILS



Speedway Australia's Adelaide office has undertaken a phone system update to assist in streamlining the flow of incoming calls. Previously, clubs would often phone the Office and have to wait while their calls were transferred to the appropriate staff member. This has now changed, with staff having individual DDI's so we may be contacted directly.

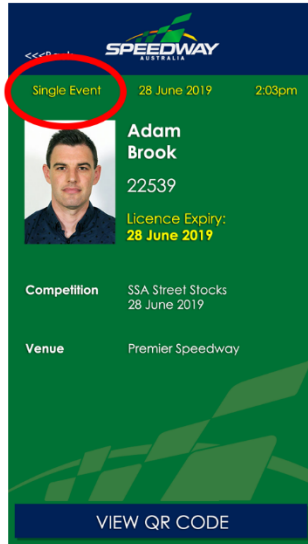


STEP 1 - CHECK LICENCE TYPE
