AUSTRALIAN AWARDS & HALL OF FAME NOMINATIONS





Did you know that every Steward is required to complete a report to the Track Operator after a race meeting using the approved form? Many Stewards also send the paperwork through to Speedway Australia by fax, which they are required to do in the event of an injury or incident occurring at the meeting.

The easiest way for Stewards to submit this paperwork is via the following link

Both the Stewards Report and Incident Report are available. Once the Steward has completed the form a copy is automatically sent to the track, to Speedway Australia, and to the Steward for their records. Please be aware that the Steward may be required to fill out the incident report when required and can't delegate it to the injured party or their crew etc.

In the coming months, Speedway Australia **will be auditing Stewards reports** from time to time, to ensure this important function is being fulfilled. If we aren't receiving copies of the reports already we'll have to follow this up with tracks after the fact, so thanks in advance for your assistance with this.

SPONSORS / MECHANICS DAY

The end of season is approaching for many tracks and you might start looking at holding a come and try for your sponsors, mechanics and officials to say thank you.

A Sponsors / Mechanics Day can be run under a Practice Permit which needs to be obtained from Speedway Australia. Please keep note that these events can only include practice sessions and such like. If there is any racing taking place, a full meeting permit needs to be obtained.

All participants need to obtain a Practice Day Licence for the relevant division via the Speedway Australia website [here](#).
