DAY LICENCE REMINDERS

As most of you will be aware, our process for day licences changed some time ago to a fully automated online system. However, we have still received paper applications in the post that some drivers have picked up from race track offices.

All old paper old day forms should no longer be in use and all day licences should be purchased via our website – the most important reason being that they are \$10 cheaper!

It's also very important for all tracks to make sure that relevant officials are checking the dates of any day licences to make sure they have been purchased for the correct event and track. Competitors in extraneous events the likes of a demolition derby may be using either a full licence or day licence, depending on their situation. It's important that all competitors on track at anytime have the correct licences to ensure the safety of everybody involved.

Also, a quick reminder that if any of your events are cancelled before competition begins, anybody who has purchased a day licence may have that refunded or transferred to the rescheduled event date.

We have included a photo example here of what an auto generated day licence currently looks like. Please make all relevant officials aware of this.

AGE OF CHILDREN IN THE PIT AREA

We've received a few enquiries lately relating to children in the pits and the ages of which they may be there. It's important that all tracks and divisions are away of the rules surrounding this. As per Rule **18.1.11** in the Speedway Australia Rulebook, children under the age of 16 years are not permitted in the Pits, except for;

- Children aged 12 to 15 years who possess a Speedway Australia Licence and/or Personal Accident Insurance; and
- Children aged 5-11 years who possess a Speedway Australia licence and/or Personal Accident insurance and are actively competing in the race meeting.

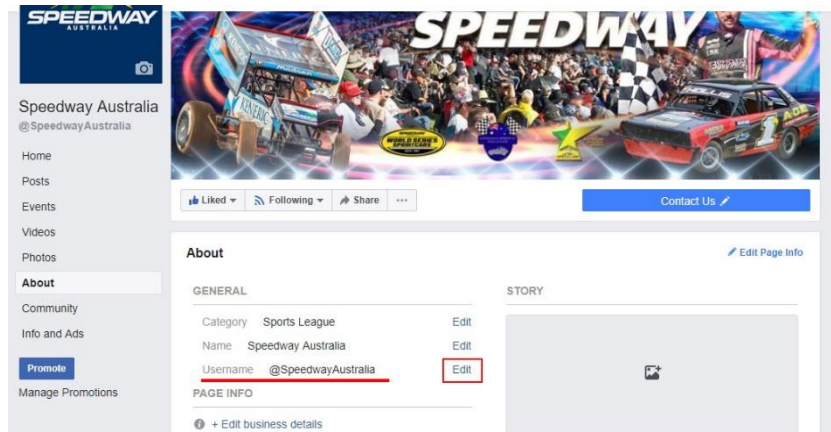
SECURE YOUR FACEBOOK HANDLE

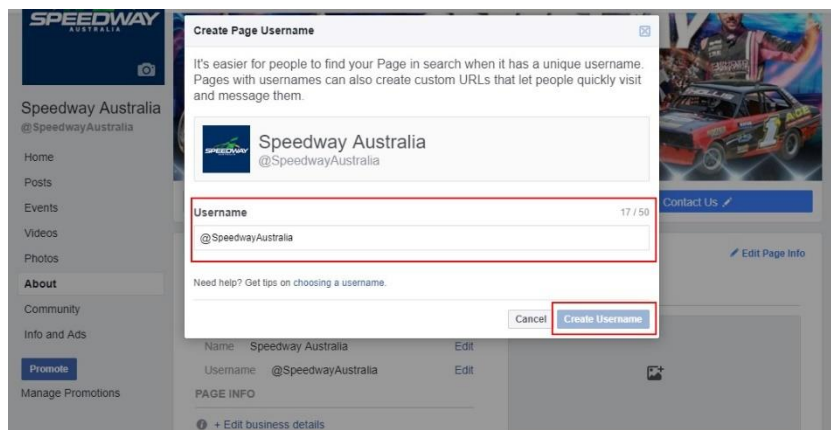
STEP ONE – Click the 'About' tab



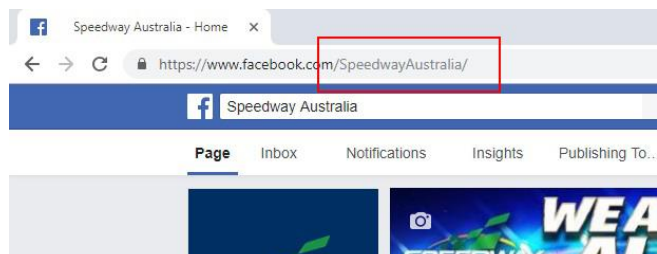
STEP TWO – Click 'Edit' next to your username section.



STEP THREE – Type in your desired username, ideally your track or division title and try to keep it as short as possible. You may have to try a few options depending on availability of the name you'd like. The box will either show a green tick or a red line telling you whether the name is successful. Once complete, hit 'create username'
