COMMITMENT TIME!



Every venue will by now have received details of the Speedway Liability Insurance offer for participating tracks and clubs for the period 31 October 2021 to 31 August 2022.

Gallagher have made contact via email to each and every Speedway Australia venue, with a comprehensive how-to through both the Renewal Letter and Procedure Guide, to help walk clubs through the process smoothly.

Venues in the process of completing

the commitment form are reminded check each of the links and attachments contained in the email, to make certain continuity of cover is maintained seamlessly ahead of the upcoming season.

Some of the information required by Gallagher includes;

- · Completion and return of your Commitment Form to Gallagher
- Gallagher will issue your deposit premium invoice once commitment form is received

Upon payment of your deposit premium to Gallagher, Gallagher will notify Speedway Australia's Mark Holmes and Liz Weaver, who will then grant you access to our online permit portal discussed in previous eNews editions.

As in previous years, the deposit premium will be used to offset future invoices, meaning for many tracks their first event in the new season will already be paid for in advance once the commitment form is forwarded.

SSA GO BOOSTS REGIONAL EVENTS



As the nation re-emerges from the second wave of COVID and tough border stances are relaxed, venues can breathe a sigh of relief in the hope that travelling competitors may once again appear at their major events in 2021/22.

Speedway Sedans Australia have been at the forefront of new initiatives targeting participation at major regional events, in particular through their SSA-GO travel fund, which will be available once again throughout the upcoming season.

SSA-GO is available to all Speedway Sedans Australia registered competitors to help enable them to compete in interstate events that require long-haul travel in excess of two thousand kilometres interstate from their residence or may be used to travel to and from Tasmania across Bass Straight to help with the shipping costs associated with that journey.

For the upcoming season, a total of \$30,000 will be distributed in the form of one-off payments of \$500 per competitor upon application until such time as the fund is extinguished.

With the sport facing an unprecedented challenge in the wake of COVID-19, Speedway Sedans Australia has stood by this funding program to help its clubs, associations, tracks ensure they maintain strong fields of cars, and safeguard their successful events throughout 2021/22 and beyond.

Venues hosting major SSA events who wish to seek out interstate competitors are encouraged to promote this initiative, with the application form available at www.speedwaysedans.com.
